During the summer, students entering 6th, 7th or 8th grade are required to read two (2) books from the following list. Book reports are required for each book and both reports must be turned in on Friday, August 21. Late reports will not be accepted and will effect the 1st Quarter grade.

Students cannot read books previously read or studied in class. Book reports may not be completed using the same books as used in previous years.

The book report format includes: title, author, characters, setting, a summary of the story, an opinion of the book, and a recommendation to future readers. The book reports must be typed.

Page Set-up

12-point Font (Arial, Times Roman or other plain font)

Double-spaced

1" Top and Bottom Margins

1" Left and Right Margins

First Page (all on same page)

Title

Author

Setting

Main Characters

Second Page

Summary of Events (should be 1 ½ to 3 pages)

Third and Succeeding Pages

Summary of Events (completion)

Conclusion

Recommendation
